The Section manager refers to the Director of the Vaccine Development Department.

### Job description

- Planning and budgeting of clinical trial activities using project planning tools
- Preparation of clinical development plans for new and existing products
- Securing compliance to the current Pharmacovigilance and ICH GCP guidelines
- Securing oversight of outsourced clinical trial activities
- Functioning as clinical trial manager in some trials

### Qualifications

- Relevant scientific education combined with minimum five years of working experience preferably in clinical development of medicine and preferably with a medical background
- Extensive experience with GCP
- Experience with performance of clinical trials
- Knowledge of immunology and vaccine requirements is advantageous
- Good communication skills and fluency in English both orally and in writing
- Management experience is an advantage
